INTENSIVE IN-COMMUNITY (IIC) SERVICES

Bio-Psychosocial Needs Assessment:

Call the New Jersey System of Care at 1-877-652-7624 if you are the parent or legal guardian of a child with behavioral and/or emotional challenges. One of our licensed clinicians can complete a comprehensive psychosocial evaluation with the goal of identifying the challenges faced by your family, the strengths and current needs of your family. A proposed intervention plan is consequently recommended to the New Jersey System of Care on your behalf.

Intensive In-Community Services:

Home based supportive therapeutic services are provided to the child and family by a licensed clinician, which include clinical consultations, individual therapy and/or family therapy.



INTENSIVE IN-COMMUNITY (IIC) SERVICES

Behavior Assistance Services:

These services aim to address specific-targeted behavioral issues. The goal of these outcome oriented interventions is to increase age appropriate adaptive behaviors.

Mentoring Services:

These services are provided to support the parent and/or child and seek to introduce them to a role model, a community liaison, someone who provides additional companionship support, and guidance.
