Related Services

SPEECH, PHYSICAL, AND OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY ARE:

- Part of every student's education program and provided in and out of the classroom, both individually and in a small setting.
- Skill specific groups include fitness, sports, sensory feeding, pre-vocational, social skills, functional play skills, sensory speech, range of motion, gait training and yoga. These skills provide a safe, comfortable space for 1:1 work with therapists, or in one of our specialized rooms.



SENSORY ROOM mats, swings, dark room, and activities that provide sensory input and enhance sensory processing, fine motor skills, and motor planning.

PHYSICAL THERAPY GYM includes a variety of small and large group activities that students use to work on gross motor skills such as walking, jumping, throwing or lifting.

TECHNOLOGY ROOM with state of the art technology including computers, iPads and a Smart Board.

LIFE SKILLS ROOM includes living and dining areas, office skills area, group work area.
