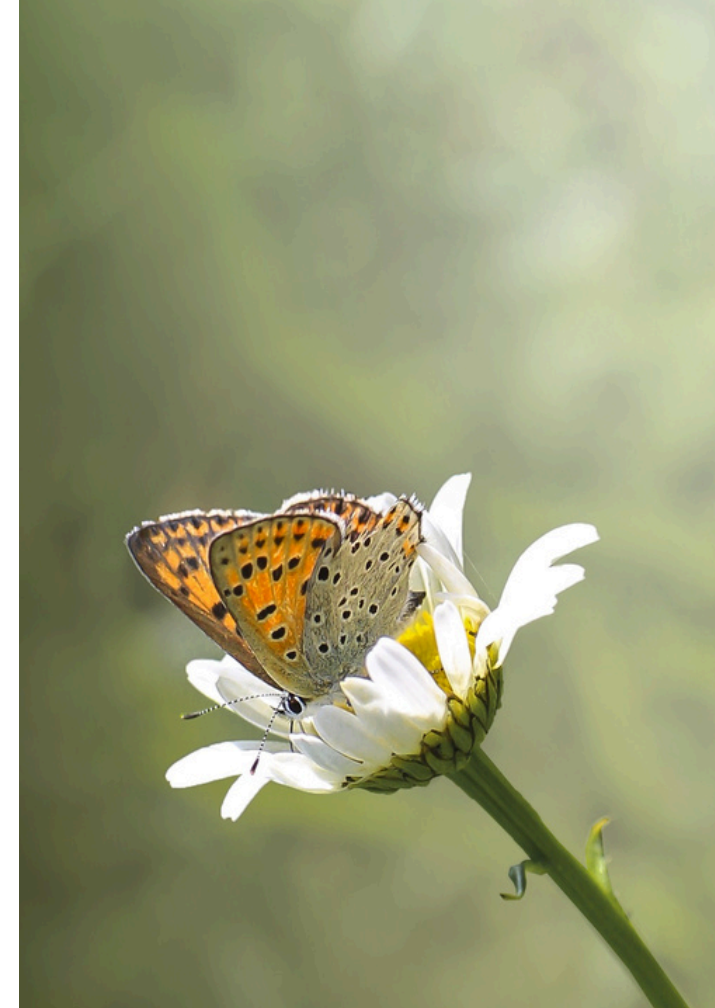

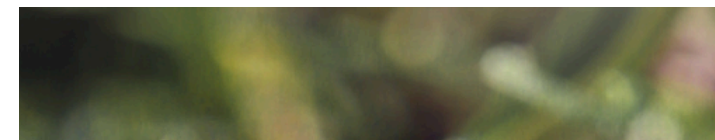

## A Diagnosis is the First Step

Under the guidance and supervision of Dr. Jennifer Cope, we provide high-quality autism assessments of children up to age twenty-one.

Our staff works one-on-one with the children for 60-90 minutes using the Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule (ADOS) test.

Patients are referred for external hearing evaluations, EEG, genetic testing, and other diagnostics as necessary.

Patients often need a quality assessment with medical oversight to access therapy and school services.



## Family Support



An autism diagnosis is the first step in a parent's autism journey. Our trained specialists can answer questions on everything from ABA to college.
