to provide a loving community, devoted to rebuilding, shattered lives that empowers women to fulfill their God-given purpose.

CORE SERVICES

During the course of the program, a student has the opportunity to grow spiritually, develop emotional balance, and become physically healthy and socially active in all aspects of society. The educational foundation and renewal available through the Benton Academy prepares each woman for successful reintegration into society. After graduating from the required 12-level study program, women can elect to continue to live at the Home for six months to a year for ongoing skills' training, while also working or attending college.



- Classroom study and instruction in an on-campus, faith-based Benton Academy with classes such as *Parenting Class, Dress for Success, Conflict Resolution and Anger Management*
- A structured daily work program
- A variety of healthy extra-curricular activities such as a photography class, crafts, knitting and bible study
- An alternative to traditional rehabilitation programs
- Career Readiness computer labs to ensure job skills upon exit.

OTHER SERVICES

Women & Children (Lioness & The Lamb)

- On-site childcare while mom is in classes
- 12 month minimum
- Pregnant women
- Up to 2 children (birth-5 y/o)

Crisis Center (North Carolina)

- Immediate removal from crisis situations
- 2-4 Week individual stabilization
- Begin the first month of curriculum
- Direct placement into long-term treatment

Leadership Academy

- Available upon completion of 12 months
- Provides training and equipping for women to be ministry leaders in the local church, parachurch ministries and around the world to impact people with the Gospel.



ADMISSIONS CRITERIA



- Residents must be willing and able to enter the program. Hoving Home is a voluntary program and ladies may discharge themselves at any time.
- The woman seeking help must call to complete an intake herself.
- Hoving Home is accepting a limited amount of psychiatric medications at select locations. We do not accept ladies on Medication- Assisted Treatment (MAT).
- Residents must be in overall good health.
 - Climb a bunk bed,
 - walk/stand without assistance, etc.
- All of our campuses are nicotine-free.
- Hoving Home is a non-profit and insurance is not required. We strive to make it affordable to all who want to attend.

The Home is funded through private donations from individuals, churches, corporations and foundations. All gifts are tax-deductible.

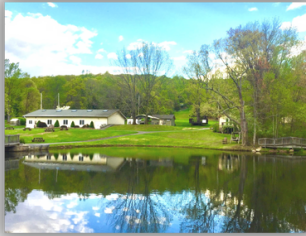
